- **15.** The tinkling sound made by the raindrops echoes in the poet's heart, bringing thousands of fancies and recollections from the past. He finds himself lost in the world of imagination.
- mesmerizing memories. The one which comes distinctly is the memory of his mother. She is fondly gazing at him and his siblings as she used to before going to her bed chamber. She appears to him just as she did then.
- 17. The pattering sound of the rain mesmerized the poet with its soothing power and prompted flashback. The poet remembered his mother's face. She appeared as she was years ago. The poet could still witness the same fondness in her look. This shows that the poet loved his mother.
- 18. No, the rain referred to in the poem is not a heavy downpour. Firstly, the pattering and the tinkling sound made by the rain on the shingles of the roof suggests its softness and calming effect. Secondly, the poet's mood suggests its soothing nature instead of the harsh one.

 - iv. The stanza highlights the sensory experiences of hearing the rain patter on the roof and feeling the comfort of the cottage chamber bed. These sensory details contribute to the vivid imagery of a cozy, rainy night that adds to the speaker's sense of bliss and tranquillity.
- 20. The poet's heart and mind react lovingly and emotionally to the sound of the rain falling on the roof. The poet is in a blissful mood as he enjoys the patter of the rain by lying down on the pillow in the comfort of his bedroom, leisurely listening to the music of the rain.

The music of the rain stirs a corresponding echo in the heart of the poet and his heartbeat starts to beat to the rhythmic falling of the rain. His mind gets engrossed in fanciful and dreamy thoughts. The rain awakens many of the poet's past memories, especially reviving the memory of his mother as she used to look at her children affectionately before she would go to sleep in her room. He recollects the fond, affectionate look of his mother which she used to cast on him and the love that she used to shower on him. Thus, the poet's mind and heart respond sensitively to the soft pattering sound of the rain falling on the roof.

The poet calls the sound of rain "bliss" because it triggers nostalgic memories of his mother and childhood. Thus, the reason correctly explains the assertion.

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
