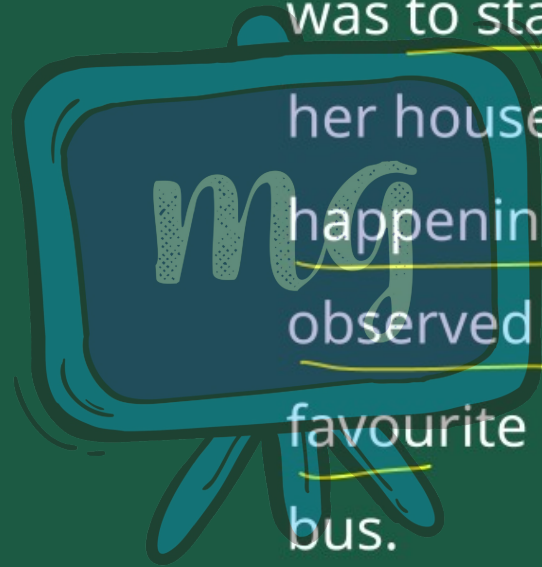

pastime?

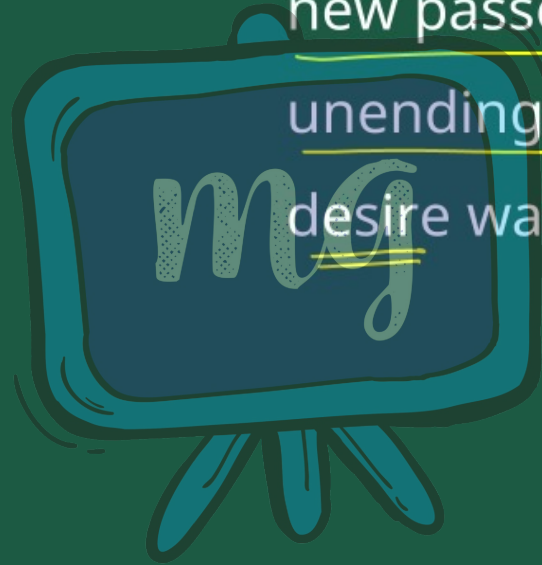

**Answer :** Valli found out that the town was six miles away from the village.

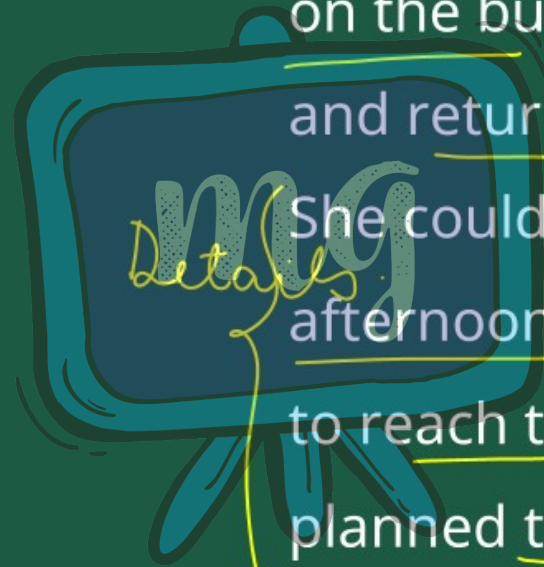
The fare was thirty paise one way. It took forty five minutes to reach town and the same bus would bring you back by taking a halt of 15 minutes.

and return home on the same bus.



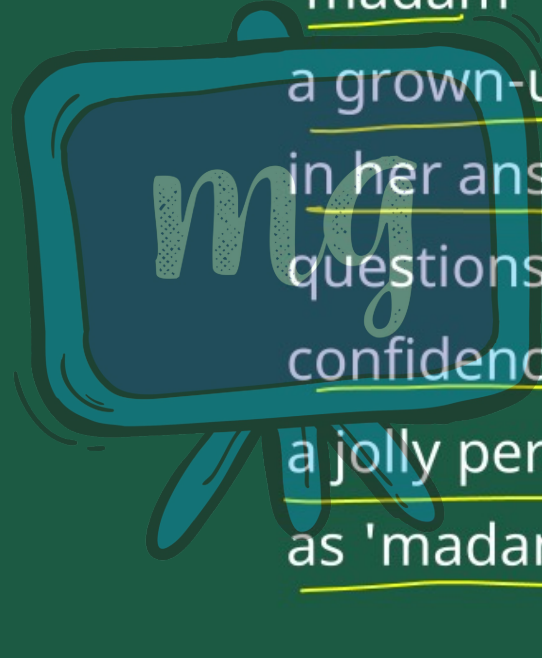
She could take the one-o' clock

seat? What does she see now?



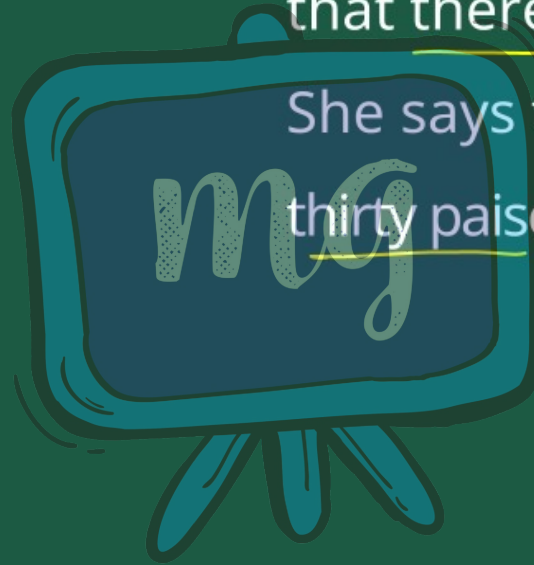

with betel juice that was likely to spill all over her lips. Seeing all this,

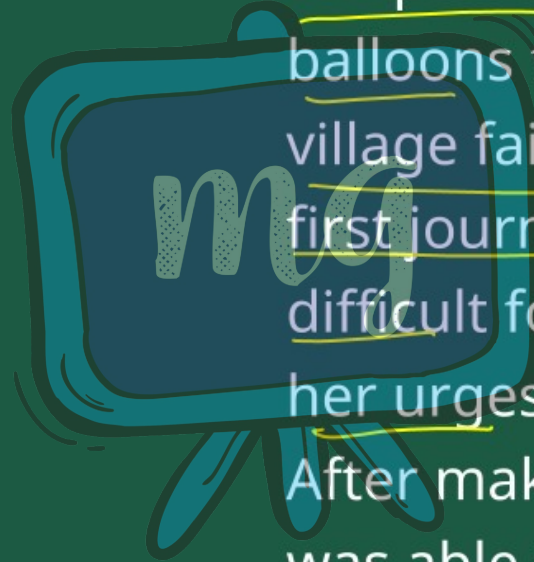
Valli did not want to make friends with that woman.

Q.1 How did Valli save up money for her first journey? Was it easy for her?



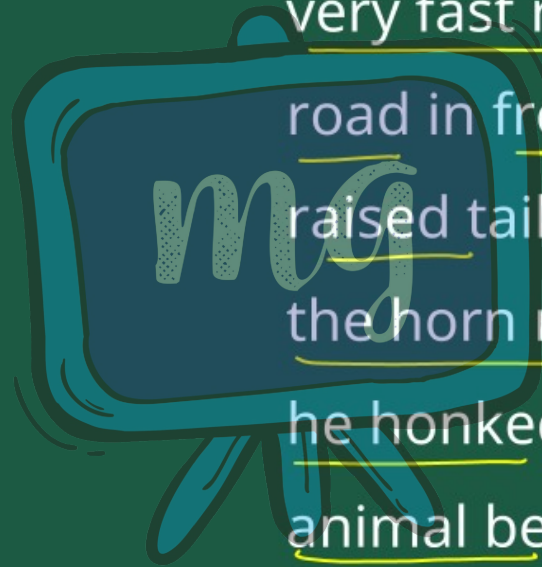

\* that made her laugh?



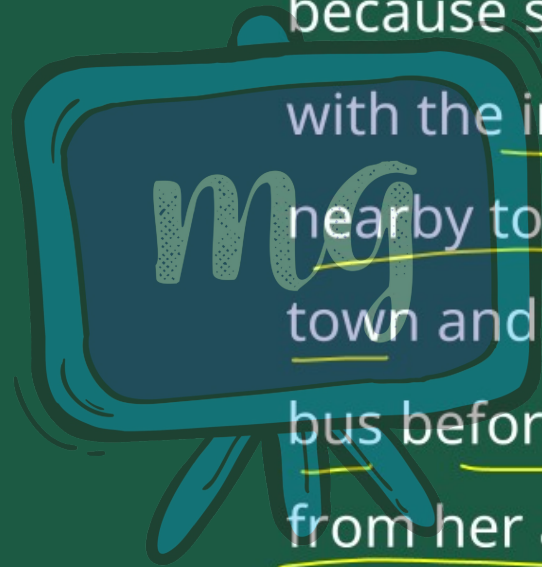
