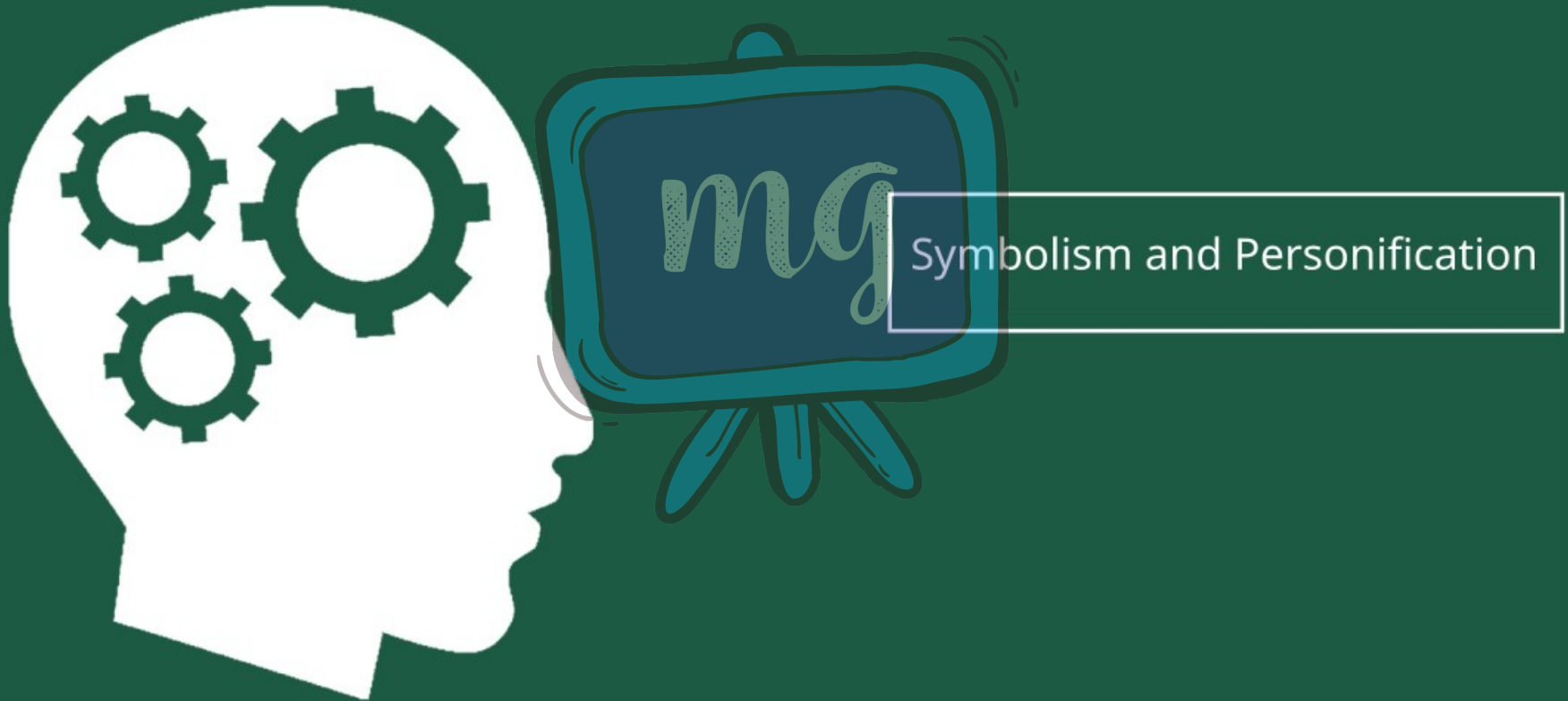

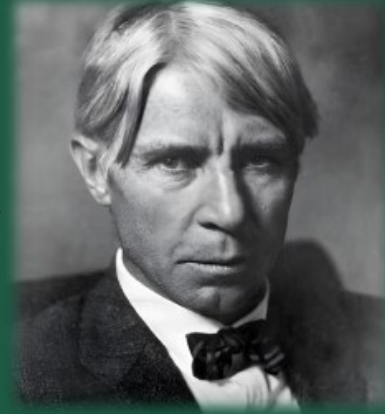


1. The Cat – footed fog

and then moves on.

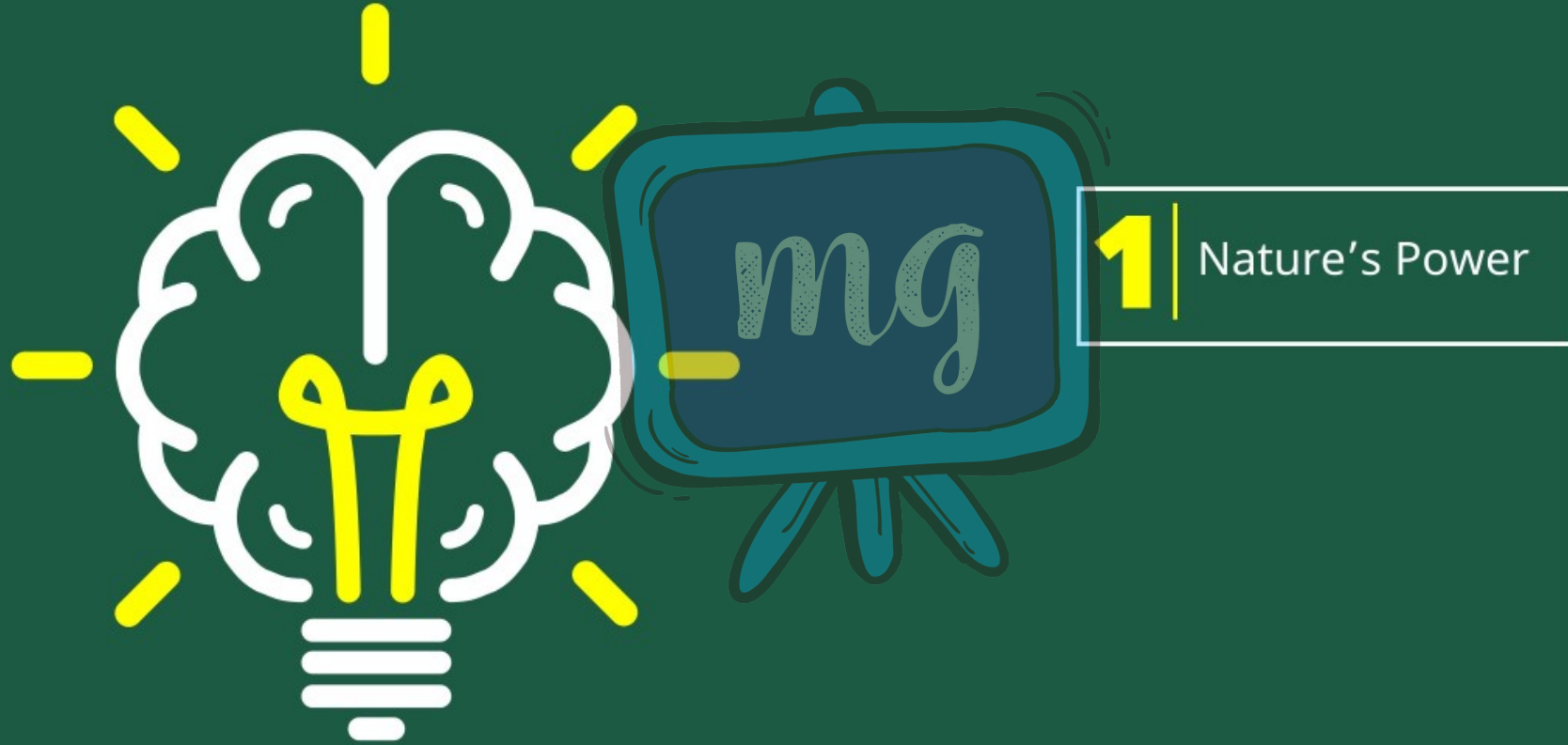
