

1. Choose the correct passive form of the sentence:  
"She writes a letter."

A. A letter is wrote by her.  
B. A letter is written by her.  
C. A letter was written by her.  
D. A letter has written by her. (B)

**Explanation :** In present simple tense, passive voice is formed using "is/are + past participle." So, "is written" is correct.

2. What is the active voice of: "The cake was eaten by the children"?

A. The children had eaten the cake.  
B. The children ate the cake.  
C. The children were eating the cake.  
D. The children eat the cake. (B)

**Explanation :** The passive sentence is in past simple tense. The active voice should also be in past simple: "ate."

3. Identify the passive voice form of: "They are watching a movie."

A. A movie was being watched by them.  
B. A movie has been watched by them.  
C. A movie is watched by them.  
D. A movie is being watched by them. (D)

**Explanation :** For present continuous tense, passive voice is formed as "is/are being + past participle."

4. Convert to passive voice: "He will complete the project."

A. The project is completed by him.  
B. The project will completed by him.  
C. The project will be completed by him.  
D. The project was completed by him. (C)

**Explanation :** For future simple tense, passive voice is "will be + past participle."

5. Choose the active voice of: "The room has been cleaned by her."

A. She cleans the room.  
B. She cleaned the room.  
C. She has cleaned the room.  
D. She will clean the room. (C)

**Explanation :** "Has been cleaned" (passive present perfect) changes to "has cleaned" in active voice.

6. Identify the sentence in passive voice:

A. The teacher gave us homework.  
B. We were given homework by the teacher.  
C. The teacher is giving us homework.  
D. We give the teacher homework. (B)

**Explanation :** This is the only option where the subject is acted upon, showing passive voice structure.

7. What is the passive form of: "Open the door"?

A. The door should be opened.  
B. The door is being opened.  
C. The door was opened.  
D. The door opened. (A)

**Explanation :** For imperative sentences in passive voice, use "let" or "should be + past participle."

8. Choose the correct active form: "The song was sung by Lata."

A. Lata had sung the song.  
B. Lata sings the song.  
C. Lata was singing the song.  
D. Lata sang the song. (D)

**Explanation :** The passive sentence is in past simple tense; the correct active form is "sang."

9. Convert to passive voice: "The manager is reviewing the report."

A. The report was reviewed by the manager.  
B. The report is reviewed by the manager. (C)  
C. The report is being reviewed by the manager.  
D. The report has been reviewed by the manager.

**Explanation :** Present continuous in passive is "is being + past participle."

10. Which sentence is in active voice?

A. The work was done by Riya.  
B. The homework had been finished by the students.  
C. The players played the match.  
D. The ball was thrown by him. (C)

**Explanation :** This is the only sentence where the subject (players) is performing the action directly, making it active voice.
