**व्याख्या:** Future simple → will be + past participle.

**व्याख्या:** Present perfect → has/have been + past participle.

6. She was singing a song.

**व्याख्या:** Past continuous → was/were being + past participle.

7. Open the door.

- A. The door was opened.
- B. The door will be opened.

- D. The door is opened. (C)

**व्याख्या:** Imperative → Let + object + be + past participle.

8. I cleaned the room.

- A. The room was cleaned by me.
- B. The room is cleaned by me.

- D. The room has been cleaned by me. (A)

**व्याख्या:** Past simple → was + past participle.

9. They are watching a movie.

**व्याख्या:** Present continuous → is/are being + past participle.

10. Did she complete the project?

**व्याख्या:** Question form → was/were + past participle (for past simple questions).
