

CHAPTER-8 | Framing Questions

1. Choose the correct question form: He is playing cricket.
- Who is playing cricket?
 - What he is playing?
 - Is playing cricket he?
 - What is he cricket playing?

(A)

Explanation : "Who is playing cricket?" is the correct structure when asking about the subject of the sentence.

2. Frame a question for the answer: "She goes to school by bus."

- Where she goes to school?
- How does she go to school?
- Why she goes to school by bus?
- When does she go to school?

(B)

Explanation : The correct question to ask about the mode of transport is "How does she go to school?"

3. Choose the correct question form: They visited Agra last year.

- Did they visited Agra last year?
- Did they visit Agra last year?
- Do they visited Agra last year?
- Were they visit Agra last year?

(B)

Explanation : In past simple tense, we use "Did + base verb" to frame the question correctly.

4. Frame a question for: "The baby is sleeping."

- Is the baby sleeping?
- Does the baby sleeping?
- Sleeping is the baby?
- The baby is sleeping?

(A)

Explanation : The correct question form in present continuous tense is "Is + subject + verb-ing."

5. Which question is framed correctly for the answer: "My father works in a bank.?"

- Why does your father work?
- What does your father do?
- Where is your father working?
- How your father works?

(B)

Explanation : "What does your father do?" is a standard question used to ask about someone's occupation.

6. What is the correct question for: "Yes, she can drive a car.?"

- She can drive a car?
- Can she driving a car?
- Can she drive a car?
- Does she drive a car?

(C)

Explanation : To confirm ability using "can", the correct structure is "Can + subject + base verb?"

7. Frame a question for the answer: "They are going to the market."

- Where are they going?
- Where they are going?
- Are going they where?
- They are going where?

(A)

Explanation : For present continuous questions with "where", the correct word order is "Where + are + subject + verb-ing?"

8. Choose the correct WH-question: "I met him at the airport."

- When did you met him?
- Where you met him?
- Where did you meet him?
- Where do you met him?

(C)

Explanation : In past simple tense, the correct structure is "Where did + subject + base verb?"

9. What is the correct question for the answer: "He bought three books."

- What did he bought?
- How many books did he buy?
- Did he buy what books?
- Which books he buy?

(B)

Explanation : The correct way to ask about quantity is "How many + plural noun + did + subject + base verb?"

10. Frame a question for: "The children are playing in the park."

- Are playing the children in the park?
- Where are the children playing?
- What are children doing in park?
- The children are playing where?

(B)

Explanation : For questions about location with present continuous, use "Where + are + subject + verb-ing?"
