- A. The dog ran down the street quickly.
- B. The dog ran quickly down the street.
- C. Quickly the dog ran down the street.
- D. Down the street the dog ran quickly. (B)

व्याख्या: Adverbs of manner (quickly) usually come after the verb they modify.

2. Jumbled: is / honest / a / man / always / an

- A. A man is always an honest.
- B. An honest man is always a.
- C. An honest man is always honest.
- D. An honest man is always sincere. (C)

व्याख्या: Standard subject-verb-object order. "An honest man" is the subject, "is" is the verb, "always" is an adverb.

3. Jumbled: very / they / happy / were / to / news / hear / the

- A. They were very happy to hear the news.
- B. Very happy they were to hear the news.
- C. To hear the news they were very happy.
- D. They were to hear the news very happy. (A)

व्याख्या: Follows the typical subject-verb-complement structure.

4. Jumbled: my / for / is / studying / brother / exam / his

- A. My brother is studying for his exam.
- B. Studying my brother is for his exam.
- C. For his exam my brother is studying.
- D. His exam is studying for my brother. (C)

व्याख्या: (My brother) + auxiliary verb (is) + main verb (studying) + prepositional phrase (for his exam).

5. Jumbled: never / tells / a / lies / good / student

- A. A good student never tells lies.
- B. Never a good student tells lies.
- C. A good student tells lies never.

D. Tells lies a good student never. (A)

व्याख्या: Adverbs of frequency (never) usually come before the main verb.

6. Jumbled: the / sun / shines / brightly / in / sky / the

- A. The sun shines brightly in the sky.
- B. Brightly the sun shines in the sky.
- C. In the sky the sun shines brightly.
- D. The sun in the sky shines brightly. (A)

व्याख्या: Standard subject-verb-adverb-prepositional phrase order.

7. Jumbled: his / father / gave / a / new / bicycle / him

- A. His father gave him a new bicycle.
- B. A new bicycle gave him his father.
- C. Him his father gave a new bicycle.
- D. Gave a new bicycle his father him. (A)

व्याख्या: Indirect object ("him") usually comes before the direct object ("a new bicycle").

8. Jumbled: to / is / school / every / Rohan / day / goes

- A. Rohan is goes to school every day.
- B. Rohan goes to school every day.
- C. Every day Rohan goes to school.
- D. To school Rohan goes every day. (B)

व्याख्या: Simple present tense for a habitual action.

9. Jumbled: the / park / children / in / are / playing

- A. The children are playing in the park.
- B. Are playing the children in the park.
- C. In the park are playing the children.
- D. Playing in the park the children are. (A)

व्याख्या: Subject (The children) + auxiliary verb (are) + main verb (playing) + prepositional phrase (in the park).

10. Jumbled: for / healthy / important / is / exercise / being

- A. Exercise is important for being healthy.
- B. Important exercise is for being healthy.
- C. For being healthy exercise is important.
- D. Being healthy is important for exercise. (A)

व्याख्या: Standard subject-verb-adjective-prepositional phrase order.
