Explanation: He cheerfully invites her to ride again and reminds her to bring the fare.

7. Whom does Valli find talking to her mother at home?
- A neighbor from North Street
 - Her teacher
 - Her aunt from South Street
 - The bus conductor (C)

Explanation: She finds her mother speaking with her aunt from South Street.

8. How is this aunt characterized?
- Strict and silent
 - A real chatterbox who keeps talking once she starts

 - The world is simple and easy to explain (C)

Explanation: She says there are many things we don't know, and even known things can't always be completely understood.

10. How does the aunt react when Valli speaks up during the conversation?
- She praises Valli's maturity
 - She asks Valli to explain more
 - She calls Valli "just a chit of a girl" who pokes her nose in like a grown lady
 - She ignores Valli and leaves (C)

Explanation: The aunt dismisses her as a little girl intruding as though she were an adult.
