

1. She said, "I am tired."

- A. She said that she was tired.
- B. She says that she is tired.
- C. She said that she is tired.
- D. She says that she was tired. (A)

**व्याख्या:** "am" → "was" (past tense); simple present changes to simple past in reported speech.

2. He said, "I will help you."

- A. He said that he would help me.
- B. He said that he will help me.
- C. He says that he will help me.
- D. He said that I will help him. (A)

**व्याख्या:** "will" → "would" in indirect speech.

3. She said to me, "Do you like coffee?"

- A. She asked me do I like coffee.
- B. She told me I liked coffee.
- C. She asked me if I liked coffee.
- D. She asked to me if I like coffee. (C)

**व्याख्या:** Interrogative sentence becomes "asked + if/whether + subject + verb."

4. Ram said, "I watched the movie."

- A. Ram said he had watched the movie.
- B. Ram said he watched the movie.
- C. Ram told he watched the movie.
- D. Ram asked he watched the movie. (A)

**व्याख्या:** Past simple → Past perfect in reported speech.

5. He said to me, "Please help me."

- A. He requested me to help him.
- B. He told me help him.
- C. He asked me help him.
- D. He ordered me to help him. (A)

**व्याख्या:** "Please" indicates a request → "requested."

6. She said, "I have lost my keys."

- A. She said that she had lost her keys.
- B. She said that she lost her keys.
- C. She told she had lost her keys.
- D. She said she has lost her keys. (A)

**व्याख्या:** Present perfect → Past perfect.

7. John said, "I am reading a book."

- A. John said he is reading a book.
- B. John said he was reading a book.
- C. John told he is reading a book.
- D. John asked he was reading a book. (B)

**व्याख्या:** Present continuous → Past continuous.

8. She said to me, "Where are you going?"

- A. She told me where I am going.
- B. She asked me where was I going.
- C. She asked me where I was going.
- D. She said me where I was going. (C)

**व्याख्या:** Question word + subject + past form.

9. They said, "We will not attend the party."

- A. They said they would not attend the party.
- B. They said they will not attend the party.
- C. They said we will not attend the party.
- D. They say they would not attend the party. (A)

**व्याख्या:** "will" → "would."

10. He said to me, "What is your name?"

- A. He asked me what is my name.
- B. He asked to me what my name is.
- C. He asked me what my name was.
- D. He told me what my name was. (C)

**व्याख्या:** "is" → "was" for indirect speech, and word order is changed.
